FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there a dirt bike ride like the trail rides in the past?

No, The Merrimack Valley Trail Riders made the decision to transition the Classic to a big bike ride, AKA The Adventure Ride for CF with optional hero sections for the more dirt-oriented riders.

What type of ride is it?

The MVTR Adventure Ride, a non-competition event for licensed motorcycle riders on fully street legal registered motorcycles. The route begins at Lakes Region Casino in Belmont, NH and consists entirely of public roads, both paved and dirt.

What kind of bike is appropriate for the Adventure ride?

Any plated bike with off-road tires.

Do I need an AMA Number?

YES - Riders must have a valid AMA membership to complete the CFF online registration. If you do not have an AMA membership, <u>CLICK HERE</u> to visit the AMA site to become a member of AMA OR to purchase a \$20 single event pass. You will receive an AMA number that you will need when your register for the ride.

Will There be Printed Route Sheets?

There will be NO printed route sheets or and no arrows hung. GPS Tracks will be supplied, and there will be limited guides available.

Can I give someone else my spot, or get a refund if I can't come?

No, registration is non-transferrable, no-shows or cancellations will be sent a t-shirt. You must have raised a minimum of \$100 by the close of registration on Sunday, June 2nd.

Can I bring a passenger?

Registered riders are permitted to have **a passenger** attend the ride and camp for the weekend and are required to pay a passenger fee of \$25.00. Passengers must also have an AMA number. CLICK HERE to visit the AMA site to become a member of AMA OR to purchase a \$20 single event pass. Is there walk-up registration on ride weekend?

No – all registration must be done online and the last day to register is June 2nd. No additional riders will be added after June 2nd. To participate, riders must have met the \$100 fundraising minimum by June 2nd.
