

FAQs

1. How much does it cost to register?
 - There is no registration fee this year, however, we encourage each climber to fundraise (or self-donate) at least \$55 to help fund a cure for CF.
2. Who needs to register?
 - Everyone who plans to enter Lincoln Financial Field, whether they are climbing or spectating, needs to be registered online, including children. Registration will close on Friday, November 19th at 1:00 pm.
3. Do I get a Tee Shirt?
 - Participants who fundraise (or self-donate) at least \$100 will receive a 2021 CF Climb event tee that will be available for pickup at Lincoln Financial Field the morning of the event.
4. What time is check-in?
 - We will be using a rolling check-in between 8:00 am and 10:30 am outside of the Pepsi Plaza at the stadium. Once you and your team are checked-in, you will be directed to make your way to the starting line. Our goal is the rolling check-in will keep people socially distanced with little to no wait to start the climb.
5. Where do I park?
 - Parking is free in Lot K which is located on the 11th Street side of Lincoln Financial Field
6. How do I meet up with my team?
 - That is up to you and your team. You can meet up in parking lot K and all check-in at once or climb at a time that is convenient for each individual.
7. Will there be a Competitive Climb this year?
 - No. There will be no timed climb this year. This decision was made with social distancing and safety in mind. Don't worry though, the plan is to bring back the timed climb for 2022.
8. Can I pass other climbers on the course?
 - Yes. Please let the climber in front of you know that you would like to pass. Please try and only pass at the top of the landing, (by concourse entrance), and not on the stairs themselves. Also, please try and to stay at least 6 feet away whenever possible.
9. Do we need to leave right after we finish climbing?
 - There will not be an award ceremony this year. Once climbers have finished their climb, cooled down and taken any photos they wanted in Pepsi Plaza, we strongly encourage people to exit the stadium.
10. What time is the event over?
 - All participants must be checked-in and inside Lincoln Financial Field by 10:30 am. All Climbers must be done with the course by 11:30 am.
11. Do I need to wear a mask?

- All CF Foundation Staff and volunteers will be wearing a face mask throughout the event. Climbers are highly encouraged to wear masks while NOT CLIMBING but should follow in accordance with local guidelines and their own comfortability level. We want everyone attending to feel safe.

12. Are vaccinations required?

- While we strongly recommend that you be fully vaccinated if you plan to join us in-person for the event, it is not required. All Cystic Fibrosis Foundation staff in attendance at the event have certified to the foundation that they have been fully vaccinated, however, we cannot guarantee that all people in attendance at the event, including participants, sponsors, volunteers, and vendors have been fully vaccinated.
